Review proposals and contract documentation to analyze best-fit for facility maintenance, upgrades, and repairs. Also research, plan, present, and receive stakeholder approval for large capital improvement projects. These include but are not limited to: new facility roof installation, large adjacent facility demolition, cooling tower & air handler replacement, autoclave upgrades, walkway & parking lot resurfacing, multiple bathroom & lobby remodels, bond room upgrades, and much more.
- Ensure compliance with all local, state, and federal requirements, including waste water, industrial air, and hazardous waste.
- Conduct interviews, recommend hiring, and perform annual evaluations of direct reporting staff.
- Confirm compliance with preventive maintenance schedule, and review and/or modify requirements as needed.
- Coordinate required inspections for the facilities as needed, and maintain all associated documentation.
- Supervise the administration and performance of construction contracts.
- Implement and maintain facilities policies and objectives.
- First point of contact for all security, fire, hazard, and business continuity issues.
- Coordinate with other departments to prevent or limit production down time on projects.
- Utilize AutoCad and DraftSight to update floor plans for any changes to offices, emergency exit routes, visitor paths, driveways, parking lots, etc.
- Develop, update, and conduct trainings of employee safety, OSHA, human factors, and respirator fit testing.
- Conduct monthly committee meetings for safety, ESG, and COVID-19 to ensure compliance and continuous improvement.
- Maintain safety supplies and ensure proper use via random spot checks.
- Complete all accident investigations and analyze trends to implement interim and permanent corrective actions or solutions.

- Manage and provide ongoing correspondence to all shareholders and FDEP within environmental remediation project.
- Develop full Environmental Management System and initiatives for environmental metrics tracking and monitoring.
- Enacted environmental policies and initiatives reducing our carbon footprint via garbage waste, water usage, and also recycling of scrap metal, paper, and cardboard.
